Medicare Quick Facts

Medicare Part A covers hospice care IF you/your loved one meet ALL of these conditions:

- Your hospice doctor and your primary doctor (if you have one) certify that you're terminally ill ONLY these two individuals can make this certification
- You accept palliative care for comfort rather than care to cure your illness
- You sign a statement choosing hospice care instead of other Medicare-covered treatments for your terminal illness and related conditions


Your costs in traditional Medicare*:

- \$0 for hospice care
- You may need to pay a copay of no more than \$5 for each prescription drug and other similar products for pain relief and symptom control while you're at home
- You may need to pay 5% of the Medicare-approved amount for inpatient respite (temporary) care provide in a hospital, hospice inpatient facility or nursing home
- Medicare does not cover room & board when you receive hospice care in your home or another facility where you live (like an Edgewood community or a nursing home)

- **Hospice Aide** Assists with patient's personal care & companionship.

- **Chaplain** Offers spiritual support & assistance with memorial & funeral arrangements.
